

RESOLUTION NO. 16-2011

Expressing the Congratulations and Best Wishes of Worthington City Council to the Members of the State Champion 4 x 200 Relay Team in the Ohio High School Track and Field Championships.

WHEREAS, Thomas Worthington High School Track Team members Kevin Girgis, Andrew Maetzold, Armand Austin and Nana Kyeremeh won the State Championship title in the 4 x 200 relay event at the Ohio High School Athletic Association Division I State Championship; and,

WHEREAS, the State Championship relay team broke the Thomas Worthington event record with a winning time of 1 minute, 27.42 seconds and beating the second place team by three-tenths of a second; and,

WHEREAS, also in the State Championship meet, Kyeremeh, Austin, Maetzold and teammate Ryan McFarland competed and finished fourth in the 1,600 relay and Austin placed sixth place in the open 400 finals; and,

WHEREAS, all four young men on the State Champion 4 x 200 relay team are juniors, and are expected to return and defend their title next year; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Worthington further wishes to recognize the outstanding efforts of Thomas Worthington High School Track and Field Coach Andy Cox for an outstanding season;
