

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2012

Approving the City of Dublin as the Selected
Municipal Appointment to the Franklin County 9-1-1
Planning Committee.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4931.42 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners has created a 9-1-1 Planning Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of convening the 9-1-1 Planning Committee is to develop a plan for adopting and modifying an effective and updated 9-1-1 system countywide; and,

WHEREAS, the 9-1-1 Planning Committee for Franklin County consists of five members, including the presiding officer of the board of county commissioner; the chief executive officer of the two most populous cities in the county; a member of a board of township trustees selected by a majority of the boards of trustees of the county; and a chief executive officer of a municipal corporation in the county selected by a majority of legislative authorities of municipal corporations in the county; and,

WHEREAS, the 2010 census results have necessitated a change in the designation of the second largest city appointment and the selected municipal appointment; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin currently serves as one of the five primary wireless Public Safety Answering Points in Franklin County and has expressed an interest in serving as the selected municipal appointment on the 9-1-1 Planning Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Chief Executive Officer of the City of Dublin is hereby approved as the selected municipal appointment to the Franklin County 9-1-1 Planning Committee.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk be and hereby is instructed to record this Resolution in the appropriate Resolution Book.
