

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2013

To Authorize a Collaborative Partnership Agreement between the City and the Cities of Dublin, Hilliard and Upper Arlington and the Townships of Norwich and Washington for a Feasibility Analysis of Shared 911/Dispatch Services.

WHEREAS, the City of Worthington has established an objective to evaluate the feasibility of a shared communications center either through consolidation or a contract service; and,

WHEREAS, a Local Government Innovation Fund grant has been awarded to study the feasibility of a consolidated public safety dispatching center for the Cities of Dublin, Hilliard, Upper Arlington and Worthington and the Townships of Norwich and Washington; and,

WHEREAS, the grant requires a local match which is proposed to be shared by the four existing public safety dispatching centers to be studied as part of the feasibility analysis; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement clarifies the manner in which the partnership will function during the feasibility analysis and the financial contributions from each entity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to enter into a Collaborative Partnership Agreement in substantially the same form as is attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk be instructed to record this Resolution in the appropriate record book.
