

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2013

Amending the 2013 Capital Improvement Program to Approve of the Reallocation of Previously Appropriated Funds for the Community Center Chemical Controllers and UV System Equipment Replacement as Identified in the 2013 New and Replacement Equipment Items.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Worthington, Ohio, provides that City Council may at any time amend or revise the Budget by Ordinance, providing that such amendment does not authorize the expenditure of more revenue than will be available; and,

WHEREAS, Worthington City Council has previously approved the Five Year Capital Improvements Program as presented for 2013; and,

WHEREAS, City Council approves each project in the Five Year Capital Improvement Program with specific funding legislation; and,

WHEREAS, City Council recognizes the necessity to amend the previously approved funding for specific items identified in the 2013 New and Replacement Equipment Items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is made the following reallocation of previously appropriated funds for the Community Center Chemical Controllers and UV System Equipment Replacement as Identified in the 2013 New and Replacement Equipment Items.

SECTION 2. That the City Council recognizes and approves the increased cost of the Community Center Chemical Controllers and UV System Equipment Replacement to an amount not to exceed Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000). The cost increase for these items will be offset by cost savings on other items identified and appropriated for as 2013 New and Replacement Equipment Items.

SECTION 3. That the Clerk be and hereby is instructed to record this Resolution in full in the appropriate resolution book.
