

SR 161 Corridor Study

ODOT is studying State Route 161 (SR 161 – also known as Dublin-Granville Road) between Sawmill Road and SR 315. The purpose of this study is to develop a strategy for improvements that are constructible and fundable. ODOT has several partners in the study effort, including Columbus, Worthington, Perry Township, Franklin County, and MORPC. You are invited to an open-house style public meeting to view and comment on alternative concepts for the corridor.


