Participants will get the opportunity to see aspects of what it is like to be a law enforcement officer and gather an understanding of the necessary tools and information needed to perform the job. The course will be taught by sworn officers and will also provide real life scenarios requiring split decision making efforts. Please join us for a fun and educational experience. This educational program will consist of the following:

1. Orientation to the Worthington Division of Police;
2. General history of policing in America;
3. Program outlining patrol operations and the essential job functions of what patrol officers do;
4. A practical exercise may be included in this program where members of the Academy would have active participation in this part of the training;
5. Patrol operation training will consist of dealing with family and domestic disturbance calls, major risk incidents, laws of arrest, search and seizure and how our criminal justice program functions. A segment of our training will deal with crime prevention.
6. Investigation training;
7. Presentation regarding drugs in our community; and
8. Terrorism – what we can do to be prepared.
