UMCH Special Meeting Reminder

On Monday, June 29th a special meeting of the Municipal Planning Commission and Architectural Review Board is taking place to give the Boards and the Worthington community a chance to hear information from Lifestyle Communities about its tentative proposal to develop the United Methodist Children's Home owned property. The meeting is taking place beginning at 6:30 p.m. at the Worthington Education Center, 200 E. Wilson Bridge Road. **Please note the unique start time and location for this meeting of the MPC/ARB.**

This is an informational meeting where the preliminary Lifestyle Communities concept will be presented. No application has been received and no vote will be taken. Before any proposal can be considered for a vote, a number of studies need to be completed, including a market study, fiscal impact analysis, stormwater evaluation and traffic study.

At this special meeting on June 29th, Lifestyle Communities will present its concept and then the floor will be open for comments and questions from the community. All speakers will be asked to fill out a speaker slip. This will assure that all comments are heard and will be a part of the official record. Speaker slips will be located at a table outside the meeting room and collected by City staff prior to the start of the meeting.
