

ORDINANCE NO. 25-2011

To Amend Section 1170.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Worthington to Modify the Setback Requirement for Political Signs.

WHEREAS, it is the wish of City Council to monitor and revise the Planning and Zoning Code of the City to ensure economic viability and preserve the character of the City; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of City Council to approve this amendment to facilitate zoning compliance for political signs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 1170.07(c) be revised to read: Political signs pertaining to the election of one or more persons to public office or to one or more public issues shall not be greater than twelve square feet in sign area and may not be located in any public right of way. Such signs shall be removed within one week of the general or special election at which the office is to be filled.

SECTION 2. That notice of passage of this Ordinance shall be posted in the Municipal Administrative Building, the Worthington Library, the Griswold Center and the Worthington Community Center and shall set forth the title and effective date of the Ordinance and a statement that the Ordinance is on file in the Office of the Clerk of Council. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and by the Charter of the City of Worthington.
