

ORDINANCE NO. 56-2021

Authorizing the City Manager to Execute a Contract  
Between the City of Columbus Board of Health and  
the City of Worthington for Health Services.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus Board of Health has indicated its intention to provide health services for the City of Worthington during calendar year 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the provision and maintenance of health services within the City of Worthington is a municipal service requiring uninterrupted service; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager has received a proposed contract for the provision of health services to the City of Worthington by the City of Columbus Health Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the City of Columbus Board of Health for the purpose of providing health services to the City of Worthington, said service to commence January 1, 2022, and remain in full force and effect until December 31, 2022.

SECTION 2. That notice of passage of this Ordinance shall be posted in the Municipal Administration Building, the Worthington Library, the Griswold Center and the Worthington Community Center and shall set forth the title and effective date of the Ordinance and a statement that the Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and by the Charter of the City of Worthington Ohio.
