

ORDINANCE NO. 33-2011  
(As Amended)

To Amend Section 529.10 of the Codified Ordinances to Establish a Method to Regulate Intoxicants on City-owned Property and to Authorize and Direct the City Manager to Prepare and Implement Administrative Regulations to Provide for Same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 529.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the City be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

529.10 Intoxicants on City-owned Property:

- a. No person shall take any alcohol, intoxicating liquor, beer or low-alcohol beverage into or upon City-owned property unless it is approved pursuant to Administrative Regulation prescribed by the City Manager or his designee pursuant to Section 131.02
- b. Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. That notice of passage of this Ordinance shall be posted in the Municipal Administration Building, the Worthington Library, the Griswold Center and the Worthington Community Center and shall set forth the title and effective date of the Ordinance and a statement that the Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and by the Charter of the City of Worthington, Ohio.
