

ORDINANCE NO 46-2011

Accepting an Easement Across Lot Number 2 of the Worthington Mall Subdivision for Purposes of Abandoning an Existing Public Waterline Located on the Property and Allowing an Existing Pressure Reducing Valve and Appurtenances to Remain Public.

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Worthington, Ohio, wishes to abandon a public waterline located across Lot Number 2 of the Worthington Mall Subdivision; and,

WHEREAS, an easement is required across Lot 2 of the Worthington Mall Subdivision to allow a pressure reducing valve and appurtenances to remain public; and,

WHEREAS, a portion of the existing public waterline will become a private water service for the property with the remainder of the existing waterline removed from service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That City Council of the City of Worthington, Ohio does hereby accept an easement across Lot 2 of the Worthington Mall Subdivision granted by Worthington Square Venture, LLC as described on the attached Deed of Easement.

SECTION 2. That City Council of the City of Worthington, Ohio does hereby abandon any ownership of any waterlines located on the property except for the waterline, pressure reducing valve and appurtenances located within said easement.

SECTION 3. That notice of passage of this Ordinance shall be posted in the Municipal Administration Building, the Worthington Library, the Griswold Center and the Worthington Community Center and shall set forth the title and effective date of the Ordinance and a statement that the Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and by the Charter of the City of Worthington Ohio.
