

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -2012

Approving the Provisions of a Collective Bargaining Agreement Between the City of Worthington, Ohio and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council and Authorizing the City Manager to Execute Same on Behalf of the City.

WHEREAS, to the extent required by law, the City recognized the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council as the exclusive representative for purposes of collective bargaining for the Full-time Communications Technicians within the Division of Police of the City of Worthington; and,

WHEREAS, to the extent required by law, the City and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council have negotiated a tentative collective bargaining agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager has requested City Council to approve the provisions of said collective bargaining agreement following ratification by the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Municipality of Worthington, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That City Council hereby, to the extent required by law, approves the provisions of the "Collective Bargaining Agreement Between the City of Worthington, Ohio and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council for the time period commencing upon formal Ratification by City Council through December 31, 2014," including the provisions relating to economic matters for which funds are hereby approved and which will be appropriated in accordance with the City Charter at the time for the annual budget appropriation ordinance for each year of said Agreement.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager and Director of Law be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City and that the Assistant City Manager, Director of Finance, Police Chief, and Personnel Director, be and they are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement in their capacity as members of the City negotiation committee.

SECTION 3. That notice of passage of this Ordinance shall be posted in the Municipal Administration Building, the Worthington Library, the Griswold Center and the Worthington Community Center and shall set forth the title and effective date of the Ordinance and a statement that the Ordinance is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and by the Charter of the City of Worthington, Ohio.
