


Site plan: indicate location, height, & dimensions

## Code Requirements




The pool may not be located closer than 10 feet to any property line of the property on which it is located.



At least a 4 foot barrier is required around all swimming pools. The barrier must be equipped with a gate and a lock.

*The pool itself can be its own barrier if it is at least 48" and the ladder is removable/lockable.*



Portable swimming pools are permitted.

## Other Things to Note

Additional approvals may apply if your property is located within the Architecture Review District, or if you are seeking a Variance from the above mentioned regulations.

Please refer to Code section 1173.05 for a more detailed list of information on swimming pools in the City of Worthington. If the swimming pool is in-ground, or permanently above ground, with its associated electrical work, please see Chapter 1305 of the building code.
